At the northeastern coast of the Caspian Sea according to the data of the Peshnoy sea stations full freezing is observed, the ice thickness in the January 20 reached 11 cm.




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CONSULTATIVE FORECAST OF ICE CONDITIONS IN THE CASPIAN SEA FOR THE PERIOD 20 JANUARY 2024 – 3 FEBRUARY 2025



3 February

The forecast maps shown in the figure, based on data from the Global Forecasting System and incorporating remotely sensed data, show that there will be stable ice cover in the north-east of the Caspian Sea from 20 January 2024 to 3 February 2025.
