



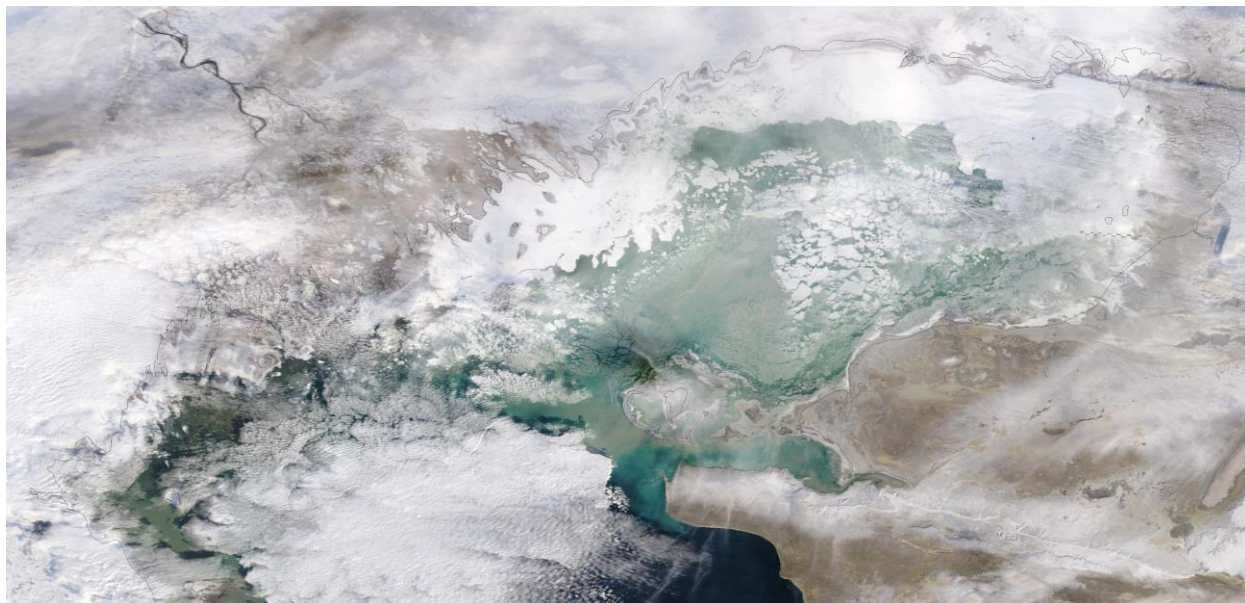

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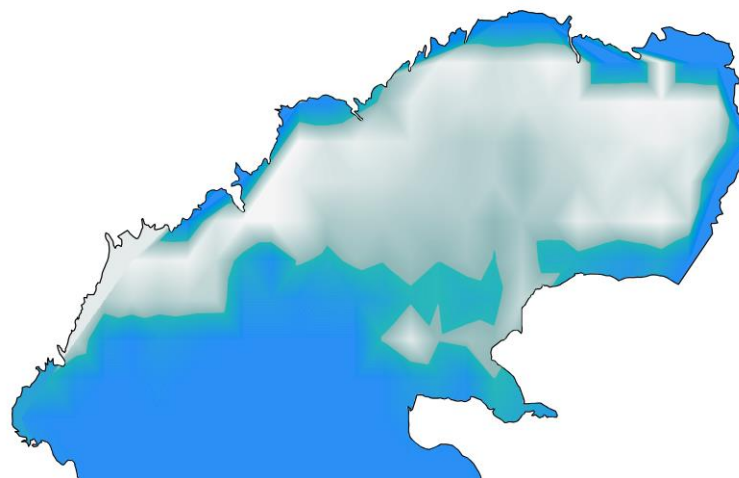
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**CONSULTATIVE FORECAST OF ICE CONDITIONS IN THE CASPIAN SEA

The forecast maps shown in the figure, based on data from the Global Forecasting System and incorporating remotely sensed data, show that there will be stable ice cover in the north-east of the Caspian Sea from 05 to 20 January 2026.
